

- •The installation and repair of this product may be done by qualified and specialized technicians, to assure every procedure are carried out in accordance with applicable rules and norms. Nonprofessional and inexperienced users are expressly prohibited of taking any action, unless explicitly requested by specialized technicians to do so.

WARNINGS FOR TECHNICIANS

- Before beginning the installation procedures, make sure that you have all the devices and materials necessary to complete the installation of the product.
- You should note your Protection Index (IP) and operating temperature to ensure that is suitable for the installation site.
- Provide the manual of the product to the user and let them know how to handle it in an emergency.
- If the automatism is installed on a gate with a pedestrian door, a door locking mechanism must be installed while the gate is in motion.
- Do not install the product "upside down" or supported by elements do not support its weight. If necessary, add brackets at strategic points to ensure the safety of the automatism.
- Do not install the product in explosive site.
- Safety devices must protect the possible crushing, cutting, transport and danger areas of the motorized door or gate.
- Verify that the elements to be automated (gates, door, windows, blinds, etc.) are in perfect function, aligned and level. Also verify if the necessary mechanical stops are in the appropriate places.
- The central must be installed on a safe place of any fluid (rain, moisture, etc.), dust and pests.
- You must route the various electrical cables through protective tubes, to protect them against mechanical exertions, essentially on the power supply cable. Please note that all the cables must enter the central from the bottom.
- If the automatism is to be installed at a height of more than 2,5m from the ground or other level of access, the minimum safety and health requirements for the use of work equipment workers at the work of Directive 2009/104/CE of European Parliament and of the Council of

- Attach the permanent label for the manual release as close as possible to the release mechanism.
- Disconnect means, such as a switch or circuit breaker on the electrical panel, must be provided on the product's fixed power supply leads in accordance with the installation rules.
- If the product to be installed requires power supply of 230Vac or 110Vac, ensure that connection is to an electrical panel with ground connection.
- •The product is only powered by low voltage satefy with central (only at 24V motors)

WARNINGS FOR USERS

- Keep the operation area of the motorized gate free while the gate in in motion, and do not create strength to the gate movement.
- Do not perform any operation on mechanical elements or hinges if the product is in motion.



CONNECTION TO WALL SWITCH OF 2 KEYS





MCONNECT SHUTTER

The MCONNECT SHUTTER was developed to control roller shutters by distance or push button, using the MCONNECT app and a module previously connected to the application. Its small size allows the installation inside a junction boxes, behind electrical switches (push buttons).

Advantages of using MCONNECT:

- · Possibility to control roller shutter and curtain motors;
- Reading the device status through working time, recognizing the opening/closing status and the respective opening percentage;
- Two inputs for validating the device status (open and closed), using external sensors (eg magnetic contacts);
- Possibility to create intelligent scenarios, which allow actions with a simple click or by voice control;
- Routine configuration for devices such as opening the roller shutters at 9 am and closing at 8 pm.


EDGE MODE

Changes the state (ON or OFF) when switch changes the position.

Ex: If the wall switch is in the open position and the shutter is closed, turning the switch to the closed position will open the shutter.








INPUTS MODE







SWITCHES MODE

Inputs are both used as switches. FCH to close and AB to

SWITCH AND SENSOR MODE

Input AB acts as a pulse switch (ignores Switch Mode), controlling up and down. The FCH input is used as a sensor/closing contact.

(Possibility to select NC/NO sensor)

SENSORS MODE

Input AB is used as opening sensor and FCH as sensor/closing contact.

(Possibility to select NC/NO sensor)

REVERSE DIRECTION

This mode, when active, inverts the outputs to the motor. The opening exit starts to close and vice versa. It is used when the installer makes the connections in reverse.

OPENING TIME

Used to indicate the time takes by the shutter to open/close, so that the opening control feedback is as real as possible.

05. CONFIGURATION

ADD MODULE IN IN THE APP

- 1 Open MCONNECT app.
- 2 Log in.
- 3 On the home page press the "+" button at the top right.
- 4 Press Add new MCONNECT.
- 5 Accept all requested permissions.
- 6 Turn on the power.
- 7 Check that the module is in pairing mode (flashing purple).

Note • if it is not in pairing mode it is necessary to reset.

- 8 Read the QR Code on the module box.
- 9 If you prefer or don't have the QR Code, can change the button to Scan nearby and select the module in the devices found.
- 10 Enter the name and password of the Wifi network you are connected to.
- 11 Wait for add process be complete.



REMOVE MODULE FROM THE APP


- 1 Press on the device you want to remove.
- 2 Press on the icon with a gear symbol on the upper right side of the screen.
- 3 Press Remove MCONNECT.
- 4 Confirm.



RESET

When resetting, the device is no longer connected to the account it is associated with in the application.

Press the reset button until the LED changes to pairing mode (flashing purple), which will confirm successful operation.



06. TROUBLESHOOTING

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FINAL CONSUMERS/TECHNICIANS

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
The LED reader does not light up	Check that the power is connected correctly.
The module is not in pairing mode (LED flashing purple) and I haven't configured it yet	Press the Reset button located on the back of the module, until it switches to pairing mode.
The module has the red LED	Make sure the network you configured the module on is available. Check if you have coverage of the network to which the module is connected. Check if the network you have configured the module has Internet access.
The module has the blue LED	Check if the network you configure the module has Internet accesst.
The output does not change state	Check that the connections are correct.
The switch does not change the state output	Make sure the connections are correct. Check the App if the switch mode is in the correct mode.
